A woman dies every two minutes due to pregnancy or childbirth: UN agencies


New data show major setbacks for maternal health in many parts of the world, highlighting stark disparities in healthcare access


In 2020, about <u>70% of all maternal deaths were in sub-Saharan Africa</u>, facing severe humanitarian crises, maternal mortality rates were more than double the world average (551 maternal deaths per 100 000 live births, compared to 223 globally).

The report shows that <u>over 4.5 million women and babies</u> <u>die every year</u> during pregnancy, childbirth or the first weeks after birth - equivalent to 1 death happening every 7 seconds - mostly from preventable or treatable causes if proper care was available.

Based on current trends, <u>more than 60</u> countries are not set to meet the maternal, newborn and stillborn mortality reduction targets in the UN Sustainable Development Goals by 2030.


